DRIVING SIGNALS RESPONSE SCENE GUIDE

ACTIVITY 4 SCENE 1

Description: This is a 2-minute 30 second drive in a small town with a school zones. The driver will be on a 4-lane median divided roadway with moderate traffic and a two-lane with on-coming heavy traffic.

Hazards: This scene requires the driver to be aware of stoplights, stop signs, pedestrian crosswalks and school zones. The driver must brake in response to traffic conditions, traffic signs and signals, and pedestrians in cross-walks.

Driver Call-outs: Have the driver call out the potential reactions and hazards they encounter along the drive. The red-indicator dot in the upper right-hand corner of the scene will que you to situations that present potential hazards.

Observer Notes: have the instructor or assigned observer identify hazard points along the drive that the driver missed or did not react to appropriately.

Discussion Points: Review those spots the driver reacted to appropriately and those that the driver missed.

ACTIVITY 4 SCENE 2

Description: This is a 1-minute 30 second drive in a suburban neighborhood. The driver will be driving on a two-way neighborhood street with traffic, parked cars, cross streets and stop signs.

Hazards: The driver must be aware of any pedestrians that will typically be in a neighborhood setting braking in response to potential hazards.

Driver call-outs: Have the driver call out the potential reactions and hazards they encounter along the drive. The red-indicator dot in the upper right-hand corner of the scene will que you to situations that present potential hazards.

Discussion Points: Review those spots the driver reacted to appropriately and those that the driver missed.

ACTIVITY 4 SCENE 3

Description: This is a 2 minute 30 second drive in a small town with two-lane oncoming traffic, turn-lanes, parked cars, retail business turn-ins, many cross lanes, cross-walks and pedestrians.

Hazards: This scene requires the driver to be aware of stoplights, stop signs, pedestrian crosswalks and school zones. The driver must brake in response to traffic conditions, traffic signs and signals, and pedestrians in cross-walks.

Driver call-outs: Have the driver call out the potential reactions and hazards they encounter along the drive. The red-indicator dot in the upper right-hand corner of the scene will que you to situations that present potential hazards.

Discussion Points: Review those spots the driver reacted to appropriately and those that the driver missed.

ACTIVITY 4 SCENE 4

Description: This is a 2-minute drive in a small town with two-lane oncoming traffic, construction zones with barrels and lane markers, turn-lanes, parked cars, retail business turn-ins, and many cross lanes.

Hazards: This scene requires the driver to be aware of stoplights, stop signs, and pedestrian crosswalks. The driver must brake in response to traffic conditions, traffic signs and signals.

Driver call-outs: Have the driver call out the potential reactions and hazards they encounter along the drive. The red-indicator dot in the upper right-hand corner of the scene will que you to situations that present potential hazards.

Discussion Points: Review those spots the driver reacted to appropriately and those that the driver missed.

ACTIVITY 4 SCENE 5

Description: This is a 2-minute 45 second drive in a downtown college campus area with three-lane one-way traffic, turn-lanes, bike-lanes, and many pedestrian cross-walks.

Hazards: This scene requires the driver to be aware of stoplights, stop signs, and pedestrian crosswalks. The driver must brake in response to traffic conditions, traffic signs and signals.

Driver call-outs: Have the driver call out the potential reactions and hazards they encounter along the drive. The red-indicator dot in the upper right-hand corner of the scene will que you to situations that present potential hazards.

Discussion Points: Review those spots the driver reacted to appropriately and those that the driver missed.
